

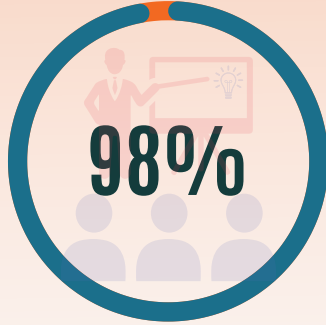

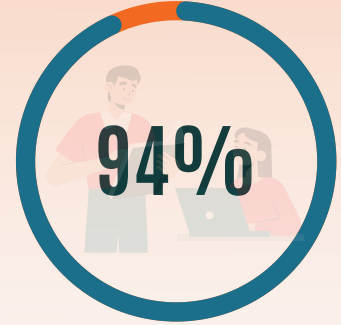
Ready from Day One To grow as effective teachers



of hosting and/or hiring principals say the program prepares residents to be effective teachers (SY 20-22)



of residents say they were very well prepared to be a teacher of record (SY 20-22)



of Clinical Instructors (mentor teachers) say that residents were very well prepared to be a teacher of record (SY 20-22)

of hiring principals say graduates positively impact school culture (SY20-22)



of hiring principals reported residents are more prepared than other new teachers to build, nurture, and facilitate relationships with students and families (SY22)



of host Clinical Instructors reported residents are well prepared to adapt the curriculum to reflect the assets of students, the school, and community (SY22)

Student Engagement and Achievement

For SY22 Project Inspire residents, 83% of host classrooms report above-median scores for residents in effective teaching and essential elements of instructional practice, rooted in equity and inclusion, as reported by students.

of CIs say being a mentor has better positioned them as teacher-leaders in the school/district (SY20-22)



of CIs say being a mentor makes them a more effective teacher (SY20-22)



of residents say that CI provides feedback that improve the resident's teaching practice (SY20-22)

Project Inspire Program Snapshot

- 12 cohorts of residents since School Year 2010
- 208 total residents enrolled
- Program of the Public Education Foundation
- Partners with Hamilton County Schools, AmeriCorps, the University of Tennessee-Knoxville, Lee University
- 3 full-time staff, 2 part-time staff



AmeriCorps

Teacher Retention

- 74% program retention
- 80% completed 4-year commitment
- 107 graduates are teaching in Hamilton County schools
- 24 graduates are teaching in other districts/schools
